


**COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

STANDARD FOR LIDAR SPEED MEASUREMENT DEVICES**

I. Purpose:

Pursuant to Section 46.2-882 and 2.1-446 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, the Division of Purchases and Supply (DPS) has established this Standard for LIDAR (Light Detection and Ranging), more commonly known as Laser, for use by Law Enforcement Authorities of the Commonwealth of Virginia for the measurement of the speed of motor vehicles.


II. Authorized LIDAR Instrument Certification:

The International Association of Chiefs of Police (The IACP) has tested and certifies that the speed measuring instruments ([Lidar Consumer Products List](#)) provided as a single "click" on their website (<http://www.iacp.org/profassist/radar.htm>) meet all requirements of the lidar speed-measuring device model minimum performance specifications, as published by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the USDOT and adopted by the Highway Safety Committee of the International Association of Chiefs of Police. The speed-measuring units referenced are authorized for used by Law Enforcement Authorities of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
